The Coming Enforcement Unit at DKPTO

What tasks will it perform?

- I. Guidance in specific cases of counterfeiting and piracy
- identical or nearly identical products, trademarks or designs
- registered IP rights valid in Denmark (trademarks, designs, patents and utility models)

Legal basis in the adopted bill







Guidance is specific cases;

- whether a counterfeiting or piracy infringement was comitted or not
- possible lines of action;
 - civil enforcement measures(eg through private IP advisers or the Consumer Complaints Board)
 - criminal enforcement measures.
- -> Will provide the users with a better basis for deciding;
 - whether or not to persue their case
 - how to do it
 - assistance on how to report a crime to the police



Conditions for guidance in specific cases;



- IP rights registered for Denmark (also EU trademarks)
 - no assessment of validity of registered rights
- DKPTO will not investigate the facts of the case. Guidance will be based on information provided by the users and DKPTO's searches in relevant IP registers
- Guidance is non-binding
- Verbal guidance or written opinions







- II. General guidance on infringement and enforcement issues
 - > eg legislation, preventive measures etc.
- III. Support to police/prosecutors
 - > Strengthening the already close cooperation
 - ➤ DKPTO employee working part time with IPR prosecutors (The State Prosecutor for Serious Economic and International Crime)
- IV. Gathers DKPTO's tasks and competencies within enforcement in one unit (also policy work)



Who can use it?

Consumers, businesses and public authorities

- mostly consumers and SMEs?

Price

- Written opinions; fee of EUR 200
- Other guidance; free of charge

Expetations

- Provide a better basis for deciding;
 - whether or not to pursue a case
 - how to do it (civil or criminal enforcement)
- More numerous pursuit of rights against counterfeiting and piracy (expected to lead to more cases for private IP advisers and the police)
- Launch 1 January 2016?
