Section 15 of the German Act on the Legal Protection of Designs (Design Act)

Exhibition priority

- (1) Where the applicant has displayed a design
- 1. at an <u>official or officially recognised international exhibition</u> falling within the terms of the Convention Relating to International Exhibitions signed in Paris on 22 November 1928 or
- 2. at another domestic or foreign exhibition,

he may, if he files the application within a <u>period of six months</u> following the first display, <u>claim a right of priority</u> from that date.

- (2) Notice of the exhibitions referred to in subsection (1) no. 1 shall be <u>published by</u> the Federal <u>Ministry of Justice</u> and Consumer Protection in the Federal Gazette.
- (3) The exhibitions within the meaning of subsection (1) no. 2 shall be <u>determined in each individual case by</u> the Federal <u>Ministry of Justice</u> and Consumer Protection and notice thereof shall be <u>published in the Federal Gazette</u>.
- (4) Any person who claims a priority in accordance with subsection (1) shall, before the expiry of a period of <u>sixteen</u> <u>months</u> following the date on which the design was first displayed, <u>indicate</u> that <u>date</u> and <u>the exhibition</u> and submit <u>proof of</u> that <u>display</u>. Section 14 (3) shall apply mutatis mutandis.
- (5) The exhibition priority in accordance with subsection (1) shall not extend the periods of priority specified in section 14 (1).



Exhibitions

- Official or officially recognised international exhibitions within the meaning of the Paris Convention
- Other domestic or foreign exhibitions
 - → are determined in each individual case by the Federal Ministry of Justice and Consumer Protection




Period of priority

- Period for filing the application: 6 months from the date of the first display
- Period for filing the priority documents and subsequently submission of the particulars required: 16 months from the date of the first display

Example:

10.03.2020 Date of the first display 10.07.2021 End of period for filing documents and particulars




Section 11 of the Design Ordinance


- (1) [...]
- (2) If an exhibition priority is claimed, the date of the first display and the name of the exhibition shall be indicated. A certificate shall be furnished as proof of the display (section 15 (4) sentence 1 of the Design Act), issued during the exhibition by the unit in charge of protection of intellectual property at that exhibition. The certificate shall confirm
- 1. that the design was disclosed at the exhibition,
- 2. the opening day of the exhibition and
- 3. the day when the design was first disclosed if the first disclosure does not correspond to the opening day of the exhibition.

The form issued by the German Patent and Trade Mark Office is to be used for the certificate. The certificate shall contain a representation of the actual disclosure of the design certified by the mentioned unit.



Further requirements

- Presentation of the design at the exhibition, in a way that it has been made available to the public
- Factual identity between the design displayed and the design applied for
- Personal identity between the exhibitor and the applicant















Priorities for design applications



■ Designs for which exhibition priorities were claimed




Why is this instrument so rarly used?


Alternatives to exhibition protection

- Grace period for designer
- Application before exhibition, especially using the facility of a deferment of publication
- Unregistered Community design



Grace Period

- grace period for designer according to section 6 of the Design Act
- effect: disclosures shall not be taken into consideration if they have occurred within a period of up to twelve months before the filing date.





Application before exhibition, under deferment of publication

 Section 21 Design Act: applying for the design while deferring the publication of the representation and later – after the exhibition – requesting extension to the full term of protection while publishing the design representations

Design application under deferment of publication

full protection by publishing the design representations

30 months



Unregistered Community design

Section 19 para. 2 of the regulation on community designs:

 From the date of the first disclosure of a design within the EU – which includes presentation at an exhibition– protection against copying of a design is also granted by means of an unregistered Community design
